8. Proposals for Rule Changes 2022

From West Leeds (this has been circulated to clubs)

1 Enforce one marking system throughout, whether it be stop permitted or no stop

2nd

2 Enforce one set of courses and classes, for all regional restricted, centre, and open to centre Trials.

Hard route Clubman A, Clubman B (easy route) which would mean two courses and three classes, clubman A to ride a mixture of hard route and easy route, as currently enforced in centre championship and west Yorkshire championship events

2nd

3 For club events, optional routes to be added over and above the centre and open to centre events, at the organising clubs discretion i.e.

Super hard route, and or Beginners route

4 Enforce set flag colours for each route, throughout all Trials run under the Yorkshire centre, including club events i.e.

Super hard, Pink

Hard route, Red (right) Blue (left)

Easy route, White (right) Yellow (left)
