ELIGIBILITY: - Open Event. All riders must hold a current ACU trials registration/Membership. SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos; and TSR 8.

ENTRIES: There will be a limit of 80entries and will open as soon as the permit is issued and close when full. There will be a reserve list and any spaces will be filled by these reserves who will be notified by 3rd August. Further reserves will also be accepted for any non starters notified in the week leading up to the event.

To qualify for an entry:

- Solo Riders are required to raise a minimum of £50.00 sponsorship for Prostate Cancer Research.
- Relay Team Entries are required to raise £25.00 per rider if part of a relay team (max 4 riders). Eg. 4 team members =£100.00

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COURSE. The course will consist of 5 sections of a 2 mile lap (1 mile of continuous stream)either on your own or as a team. (You DO-NOT have to complete 26 Laps, but we still would like you to raise the minimum sponsorship)

Course must be strictly followed and any course cutting will result in exclusion from the event.

TIME LIMIT:- 2.5HRS AFTER STANDARD TIME.

SIGNING ON:- Sign on will commence from 8am

START: The event will be held at Cockhill Leadmines with the 1st rider starting at 9 a.m.

The event will be Time and Observation and riders will start at intervals of 15 or 30 seconds dependent on number of entries

CATERING:- Will be available on the day.

CLASSIFICATION Riders totals will be calculated by adding their observation score to their time based on the fastest rider setting standard time with zero points and all other finishers will receive 1 point for every minute or part thereof that they are slower than this time.
